We are still receiving regular reports from both parents and members of the wider community concerned about parking on the road outside school during the drop off and pick up periods.


We would respectfully ask you once again to heed the police advice as follows:

- The best solution is to park in the Recreation Hall car park and walk the short distance to school.
- Park away from the zig zag lines at all times in the interest of our children's safety. Please avoid parking on the double yellow lines.
- Park without blocking or turning in our neighbours' drives.
- Please avoid parking on the blind bend behind the school on the Garras side.
- Avoid three point turns in the road.
