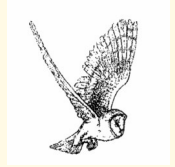

Eagle Owls – Lucy



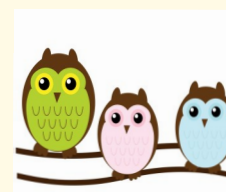
