#### A polite reminder for all!

You will all be familiar with the school buildings and the limited space we have. The cloakroom bags we have provided for the children are a great help with this, but can we please remind you that;

- The children need only bring in their coat, book bag, lunch box and water bottle on a daily basis.
- PE kits and trainers/plimsolls should remain in school (inside the cream cloakroom bags) at all times and taken home periodically for laundering.
- Rucksacks should only be brought to school when requested (usually Forest school or school trips). If your child needs to bring a rucksack occasionally for another reason, please let us now and we will arrange for its safe keeping.
