Julia Berry, PCSO, was in school on Wednesday and offered some guidance for us in relation to parking and car safety. The main points are.

- Parking and stopping to drop off is <u>prohibited</u> on the zig zag lines.
- Children should sit in the rear seats of your car, as airbags can deploy at around 200mph and cause serious injury.
- Children below 135cm tall must be on a booster seat or other appropriate car seat.

A reminder too, that 3 point turns in the road are extremely dangerous and must not be attempted. There is ample room for turning in Skyburriowe Lane.

After school club survey.

Following the news that Alison and Helly's are closing next year, we are once again looking at wraparound care.

We have emailed the parent survey once again to gauge interest, but we need to make it clear that we would need enough support to make it a viable option in order to recruit and pay for staff. We would need 2 staff as a minimum.

Having looked at the charges from other schools, both within Crofty and locally, £5 per hour (per child, not per family) would be fair and reasonable. In order to keep things as simple as possible we plan to charge £5 for each hour, or part thereof. The breakfast club charging will remain the same for now, but it may be that we bring this in line with the after school provision.
