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

School Meals price rise amendment

Please be aware that school meals will now cost £2.65 (not £2.66 as previously stated) for KS2 children.

KS1 children will still be eligible for universal free school meals.

After School Clubs (Week beginning Monday 11th September 2023)

As you are aware, we have been looking at our afterschool provision, and are still hopeful of providing the type of wraparound care that our families need. In the meantime, Mr Sturges has arranged the following clubs for September. Please bear in mind, though, that most of these clubs are provided on a voluntary basis by school staff and <u>are subject to</u> change at short notice.

Mon—'Draw It!' Club 3.15-4.15pm – Mrs Woodhead

Tues—SPORTS Club 3.15-4.15pm- with 'SupaSport SouthWest'. All children will be able to attend the Sports Club. The first session on the 12th Sept will be free of charge, as a 'taster', the subsequent sessions will be charged at £2 per child, per session.

A reminder to all parents please:
