We have been notified that there have been issues too, with parents and visitors using Skyburriowe Lane for turning.

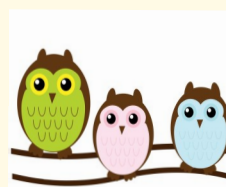
