## A safety message for parents

We are aware of some safety concerns involving schools which we want to make you aware of.

This relates to young children left in cars while parents either collect, or drop off, older siblings from/at school. The law does not say an age when you can leave a child on their own, but it's an offence to leave a child alone if it places them at risk (see link below).

Parents must, of course, be free to use their own judgement in these situations. However, if any of our parents find themselves in this situation, especially on busy days or when running late, please call the school so that we can offer help by sending a member of staff to either collect your child(ren) or escort them to your car at pick up time.
