## Should I keep my child off school?

**Yes**

Until...	Until...
Cholera	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all diarrhoea have ceased
Dysentery and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Gold and Pink Stools (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and no longer have a diarrhoeal episode for 48 hours
Impetigo	once sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after the final antibiotic
Measles	5 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics
